The Purpose and Effect:

The purpose and effect of the Application for Consent is to create a new building lot. The retained and severed portions meet all municipal policies and zoning regulations.

The subject property is located on Highway 65 and has frontage on Government Road as well as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto. The proposed new lot will maintain frontage on Government Road and Highway 65 and has a total area of 3.2 ha.
