The Roads Department was busy grading to prepare for calcium due for delivery on June 14<sup>th</sup>. Patching will be done with a spray patcher. Received a quote of \$11,458 from Demora for pulverizing. Can reduce this cost if we do the grading and traffic control. Culvert on Sales Barn Road may need to be replaced and would cost about \$4000. New dock for the boat launch has been installed, and the summer student has started the upkeep on lawn cutting. Adshead hauled gravel to Promenade.
