OCWA tried to change the grounding rings on the flowmeter to resolve issues, this was unsuccessful. The treatment of the lagoon is underway. Waiting on results to discharge.

Miller Paving Limited completed the surface treatment of Belle Vallee Road. Hauled Class II to various spots in the township to fill potholes as Miller Paving Limited is out of coldmix for patching. Class II is also being used to reshape the crown. Beavers continue to be an issue. The deck of the Rheault Bridge has been repaired. Work on the Lachapelle drain will begin this week. The Township is still waiting on locates to change the culvert near the old Pearson Bridge.

The Township of Casey received a letter from Mr. Rondeau and Ms. Robinson dated September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 regarding the poor condition of Belle Vallee Road starting from Belle Vallee to Highway 11.

The Road Superintendent informed council that since the letter has been received, a section of Belle Valle Road from the Belle Vallee Bridge to Promenade has been resurfaced with double surface treatment. The remainder of Belle Vallee Road will be graded once weather permits as opportunities to grade have been less frequent due to the lack of precipitation.
