6. Reports from Staff & Others

a. Road's Department Report

The Road's Superintendent reported that grading was done when weather permitted and it was a very wet month. Beaver dams were removed where necessary. The water break in front of the Fire Hall has been repaired. A hose was broken on each side to the curbside valve. The ploughing equipment has been installed on Trucks #7 and #9, and 520 tons of winter sand has been delivered from Adshead for the winter season. The lagoon has been discharged and everything went well. Flashing lights were installed on the speed limit signs on the west and east end of the village, and a speed limit sign was replaced on Omer Street. The stops signs on the corner of North Jelly Road and Casey Mine Road were damaged and have now been repaired. The loader tire needed to be repaired and likely one more will need to be repaired soon. Co-op fuel tanks were inspected and some electrical needs to be changed. The Road superintendent is waiting on quotes from electricians to make the necessary repairs.

b. Fire's Department Report

The Fire Department responded to 1 house fire in October, and although the fire caused some damage, the fire was extinguished and the house was preserved.
