a. Yves Sansoucy - Dust Suppressant on Maybrook Road [no item]

Yves Sansoucy discussed the dusty conditions on Maybrook Road due to the increase in traffic over the last several years. Yves said that back in 2005, during a public meeting that took place to discuss Casey residents being permitted to use Harley Landfill, traffic volume was discussed and how this may impact Maybrook Rd. Reeve Labonte and Yves Sansoucy recall the Township agreeing to apply additional calcium on Maybrook at that meeting. Yves is requesting that the invoice he received this year be reversed and more calcium be applied to Maybrook Rd each year. Council discussed the traffic increase, construction on Hwy 11 and whether bagged calcium could be applied since the Township does not have the equipment to apply bagged calcium. Yves said he would be willing to spread the bagged calcium after communicating with the Road Superintendent to ensure timing of the treatment was mutually agreed upon.

a. Earlton-Timiskaming Airport - Decertification Information

The Clerk-Treasurer outlined to Council that the Earlton Airport board is discussing whether to renew their airport certification. De-certification would not have any negative impact on the way things currently operate, and all flights that currently use the airport would still be able to use it as they do now. De-certification would save just over \$20,000 per year. Airports must have a certification if they wish to except scheduled passenger flights. Passenger flights are currently not in the foreseeable future of the airport due to several factors including lack of terminal, and other nearby airports such as in Timmins and North Bay. Trying to recertify in the future would be difficult. The board is seeking comment from member municipalities. Casey Council indicated they are okay with letting the certification go, however, all members do not want to see the airport closed and want to ensure that de-certification would not effect that in any way.
