**a. Roads Department Report:**

The Roads Superintendent reports seasonal operations continued with winter road patrols, snow plowed and sanded as needed, and snow ditching to manage flooded areas. Cold patching and large holes were filled. Having a look at potential projects for this year. Moose Creek Bridge is still closed and Council discussed closing it permanently. The Road Superintendent will barricade both ends and the Clerk-Treasurer will look into the procedure for a Stop-up and Close By-Law. K.Smart is designing a temporary support for Britton Bridge. Notre Dame and Main Street sidewalks will be removed and are not being replaced at this time. There is a driveway culvert on Notre Dame Street that needs to be repaired. Owner will be invoiced when work is completed. The cost of a new Sweeper is around \$25-30 thousand. In lieu of purchasing, the Township will hire a contractor to complete the sweeping or rent a sweeper. Regular maintenance completed on road department equipment and mull board blades on the grader were changed to summer blades. The fuel injector pump on the grader is failing and will need to be repaired.

**b. Fire Department Report:**

The Fire Department reports that they responded to a grass fire in Brethour. The owner was burning without a permit and will be invoiced for the call.
